## **Editor's Note**

The original volume is in poor condition, with parts being illegible. Blank spaces in this abstract indicate that the text was illegible and that it could not be read or interpreted. Sometimes an educated guess was made, particularly with names.

A brief history of the institution follows.

### **Origins of the Thomas Asylum for Orphan and Destitute Indian Children 1855 – 1955**

In thinking about the origins of the Asylum two main factors come into play.

First we must consider Laura Wright, wife of the Reverend Asher Wright, new missionaries from the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions who arrived at the Buffalo Creek Reservation in 1834. Later the Wrights and most of the Buffalo Creek church members moved to the Upper Mission Station at Cattaraugus. Laura Wright was childless, and was constantly taking in children. In fact, Laura Wright, more than anyone else, was the driving force behind what became the Thomas Orphan Asylum.

The second factor was conditions on the Cattaraugus Reservation. In 1847 a typhus epidemic was killing three to five people a week. In 1854/5 disease was again rampant, and many Indians faced hard times, including starvation.

In 1854, Joseph W. Peter died on the Reservation, leaving five of his children and four orphans for whom he was responsible. The Mission family took in these children. Rev. Wright received permission from the American Board to use the Mission House and to hire a woman to help with the care of the children.

The Wrights had to seek additional funds to support these orphans. Philip E. Thomas, a Baltimore Quaker, the Washington representative for the Seneca Nation of Indians, and president of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad sent \$100. People in Fredonia sent \$16.92 to purchase a cow. The reservation brass band and singers presented a concert in Buffalo which raised \$174. In total \$568.22 was raised.

On September 9, 1854 the Seneca Nation Council passed a resolution favorable to the formation of an orphan asylum. The Council authorized the asylum's managers to locate the asylum, purchase land, and seek contributions and funds to support an asylum. The asylum was to be independent of Seneca Nation government.

In January 1855, Rev. Wright and Eber M. Petit of Versailles, Commissioner of Public Schools for Chautauqua County, went to Albany seeking state support for the formation of an orphan asylum. After three months of lobbying, the Governor, on April 10, 1855, signed the charter for the Thomas Asylum for Orphan and Destitute Indian Children. The State granted \$2000 to erect a building, plus \$10 per year per child for up to 50 children.

Laura Wright's dream was becoming a reality. In a letter dated March 1, 1855, Mrs. Wright wrote to the American Board in Boston, "It is with much pleasure, and I hope with sincere gratitude to God, that I am able to say, that the long cherished desire of my heart has been granted, and an asylum for these poor little wanderers, is at length commenced."

In May 1855, the asylum's trustees purchased 15 acres from Caleb Davis for \$300. The asylum building would be constructed by Joseph Ansley of Perrysburg. The cornerstone was laid on September 14, 1855.

The first inmates were:

1. John Jemison, Onon-Catt, left Jan 1858
2. Asher W. Young, Sen-Catt
3. Asher Brandt McLane, Sen-Catt, died at the Asylum, son of the first president of the Seneca Nation of Indians
4. George Kennedy
5. William Kennedy, died at the Asylum, 21 August 1856
6. Billy Spencer, left October 1856
7. Abby Spencer, died February 1865
8. Mary Spencer, left January 1858
9. Helen Beaver, died 22 January 1865
10. Ida M. Brooks

Laura Wright wrote brief biographical sketches of each of these children to send to Albany, but only that of John Jemison still exists.

John entered the asylum Feb. 24, 1855 at age 10. His father, Charles Jemison, died of typhus fever in 1848, and his mother died at Grand River in 1851. She was Onondaga, the daughter of John Tallchief. Apparently the child had been eking out an existence at Cattaraugus as best he could on his own.

For 20 years, the asylum continued to function, often with acute financial problems.

In 1875, Asher Wright, now in his 70s, and Dr. Petit again went to Albany to lobby for a state take-over of the asylum. This was eventually accomplished. The asylum was transferred to the State Board of Charities. In 1900, the school was rebuilt, and in 1905 the name changed to the Thomas Indian School. The school closed in 1956.
