Note.—all these persons, with the exception of the last named, have been married according to their heathen manner & have all with one exception raised families. The first named a chief of 40 years of age, is now a grand-father;--the fourth named is the father of wife of the last. They have now solicited marriage in the Christian form, from a conviction of duty—with a view 1st: To Give then public attestation in favour of Christian institutions & 2nd to recommend the same by their example to the practice of their brethren of the Seneca Nation.”

Buffalo N.Y. who desposed and says that a book which she has with her known as the Register of the Seneca Mission containing a marriage record of the marriage of Caleb Davis to Cassandra daughter of Oliver Silverheels dated: April 10th 1847. that this book was kept by Asher Wright who was the missionary on the Cattaraugus Reservation at that time that she also knew all of the above mentioned parties and that to the best of her belief and knowledge—the records shown herein all correct.
