They have now solicited marriage in the Christian form, from a conviction of duty-with a view $1^{\text {st: }}$ : To Give then public attestation in favour of Christian institutions \& $2^{\text {nd }}$ to recommend the same by their example to the practice of their brethren of the Seneca Nation."

Buffalo N.Y. who desposed and sys that a book which she has with her known as the Register of the Seneca Mission containing a marriage record of the marriage of Caleb Davis to Cassandra daughter of Oliver Silverheels dated: April $10^{\text {th }} 1847$. shat this book was kept by Asher Wright who was the missionary on the Cattaraugus Reservation at that time that she also knew all of the above mentioned parties and that to the best of her belief and knowledge-the records shown herein all correct.
