### VITAL RECORD POSTINGS OF AN INDIAN MISSIONARY IN WESTERN NEW YORK, 1832-1879

Recently the State Library in Albany acquired the unpublished record book of Asher Bliss, a Congregational clergyman and missionary to the Seneca Indians of western New York. The vital records which follow, many of them from the counties of McKean and Warren in Pennsylvania, are drawn from this source. Frequently the original postings, here altered in form only, leave the reader uninformed as to whether the individuals of reference are Indians, white persons, or persons of mixed ancestry.

This missionary, son of Simon and Lucy (Southworth) Bliss, was born in West Fairlee, Vermont 20 February 1801. After graduating from Thetford (Vermont) Academy he earned B.A. and M.A. degrees at Amherst College in 1829 and 1832 respectively. Prior to 1832 he was graduated from Andover Theological Seminary. He was ordained as a missionary by the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions at Post Mills Village, Vermont, 25 September 1832.

From 1832 to 1851 he served as missionary to the Seneca Indians at tarausgus, New York. He continued in the same capacity for the Am Home Mission Society at Corydon, Pennsylvania, 1851 through 1854 and in western New York, 1854 to 1856. In 1856 and 1857 he served as "supply pastor" at Stockton, New York. From 1856 through 1867 he was mentioned at "Alleghany Mission, New York." He was "without charge" from the latter year until his death in Onoville, town of South Valley, New York March 1881.
